The Malta House of Care medical clinic provides free, high-quality primary health care to uninsured adults in Greater Hartford, always with compassion and respect. This is made possible by the incredible 59 volunteer doctors, nurses, and other medical professionals who contribute \$2.5 million of in-kind professional care, as well as thousands of generous financial supporters. Since its inception in 2006, Malta House of Care conducted more than 60,000 patient visits. The establishment of this stationary clinic will dramatically expand program services. Malta will more than double its service hours at Asylum Hill with a stationary clinic and will be able to serve more than 2.5 times the number of patients currently possible to serve on the van.
