Due to the Chancery repair work and Archives closures, the Office of the Archdiocesan Archives will only hold one **"open collection period"** this year for depositing/donating records with the Archives and/or Records Center. Records/materials will be accepted **November 4th through November 22nd**.

Please do not send records/materials to the Archives outside of these dates. Please contact the Archives prior to sending any records/materials to the Archives.

- If you, your office/ department, parish, school, committee, organization, etc., have records/ materials packed and inventoried, please contact the AOH Archives to obtain proper transfer forms and arrange a date and time to drop your records/ materials off at the Chancery.
- If you do not have your records/ materials ready don't worry! You can send items in 2025 during the twice-yearly "open collection periods" (dates to be announced in early spring on the AOH Archives website).
