Please note that this year's "open collection period" is quickly approaching and will be November 04-22. Please have your record packed and ready to send to the AOH Archives before November 04. 


SACRAMENTAL RECORDS

Just a reminder, the AOH Archives <u>does **not**</u> hold or <u>administer</u> Sacramental Records. The parishes are responsible for maintaining and administering the records (including those from their origin to the present). If your parish is missing and/or has any damaged Sacramental Records (parish itself and/or any subsumed parishes), it is the responsibility of the Pastor to promptly notify the Chancellor in writing.

When a parish directs individuals to the AOH Archives, because it is unable to locate Sacramental Records, the Archdiocesan Archivist is obligated to report the parish to the Chancellor. Likewise, the Archivist is unable to assist the individuals, as the AOH Archives does not hold the "missing" registers.

A parish is responsible for obtaining an authenticated replacement copy of lost or damaged registers (as applicable) through the process of writing the Chancellor.



Please remember that Sacramental Records are private records of a sacred nature and not, public census records or open genealogy sources.
