• AOH Archives website revamped and relaunched

 Sr. M. Clare Millea, ASCJ, appointed Assistant Chancellor (in preparation to becoming new Chancellor) – Archivist begins reporting to Sr. Clare as Fr. Lerner engages other AOH responsibilities

March - August

 AOH Central Administrative Offices relocate from Chancery (Hartford, CT) to Pastoral Center (Bloomfield, CT) - Archives remains at Chancery and assists relocated offices with packing and transferring of official records to Archives

June – July

 Archives provides research assistance to Office of Property and Assets for landscaping project (part of 2018 Cathedral Campus Revitalization Project)

July 15

 Official 2018 AOH-wide "Litigation Hold Order" lifted by Chancellor (new restrictions applied to AOH Archives by AOH Administration and AOH Legal Counsel)

September

• First Location Guide for Parishes & Sacramental Records completed (posted to Archives website)

December 13

• Nicole Besseghir, CA, MSLIS, resigns as Archives Assistant

March 11

 World Health Organization (WHO) in Geneva, Switzerland, declares COVID-19 a pandemic (Vatican City begins closure on March 08, 2020)

March 17

• AOH Central Administrative Offices (includes Archives) close due to COVID-19 (all operations suspended)

June 01 – May 2021

 AOH Central Administrative Offices (includes Archives) start "soft re-opening" and begin hybrid work model - Archives operates on a modified schedule and enacts COVID-19 protocols and quarantine guidelines

June 20

 Sr. M. Clare Millea, ASCJ, resigns as Assistant Chancellor to serve her Apostle mission in Ireland - Fr. Ryan M. Lerner remains as Chancellor

- Archives engages major records transfer project with Pastoral Center (continuation of 2019 relocation of AOH Central Administrative Offices)
- Additional storage and work space secured in Chancery for Archives by Vicar General/ Moderator of the Curia and the Chancellor

February - May

• Archives collaborates with Hartford Bishops' Foundation on signage project for Cathedral Campus Memorial Garden

April 03-25

• AOH Central Administrative Offices (includes Archives) disrupted by cyber-attack (temporary loss of all IT services)

May 19

 AOH Central Administrative Offices (includes Archives) return to new COVID-19 work schedule (full work week, but shortened hours) - AOH Archives COVID-19 protocols remain in effect

Late June

 AOH Archives re-starts conversations with O'Brien Library regarding rare book preservation project

July 01

 AOH Archives resumes limited service to AOH Administration and external researchers while continuing internal restructuring process and navigating ongoing COVID-19 issues

Late August

- Review and updating of departmental policies begins along with processing of accessions backlog
- Internal Records Management Program re-started (halted in March 2020 due to COVID-19)

September 13

 AOH Central Administrative Offices (includes Archives) return to pre-pandemic (COVID-19) work schedule with new work hours - Archives maintains necessary COVID-19 restrictions

disrupted by 2nd cyber-attack (temporary loss of all IT services
and phone systems) - Archives digital files, emails, and phone
messages compromised (all Archives services suspended and
cooperation with O'Brien Library halted as damage is assessed
– digital files, emails, and phone messages deemed lost and/or
irretrievable by IT Dept.)

• Fr. Ryan M. Lerner, Chancellor, appointed to new position in New Haven by Archbishop Leonard P. Blair (Chancellor position vacant until January 2022)

• Fr. Christopher M. Ford, J.C.L, begins appointment as new Chancellor

January – October

 Inventory recovery audit of Archives general holdings conducted (result of compromised digital files from 2021 cyber-attacks)

February

 AOH IT restructuring process begins across AOH (includes Archives) – results in periodic disruptions of IT services (delays in Archives services)

March - October

 Majority of compromised Archives digital files manually reconstructed by Archivist

August - November 04

 Finance Department relocates from Chancery (Hartford, CT) to Pastoral Center (Bloomfield, CT) – Archives remains at Chancery and assists Finance Department with packing and transferring of official records to Archives

Late September

 Collaboration with O'Brien Library resumes and rare book preservation project launched

June 26

- Archbishop Blair announces 2024 retirement
- Bishop Christopher J. Coyne (Diocese of Burlington, VT) appointed Coadjutor Archbishop of Hartford

• High-density industrial dehumidifier installed in Archives

November

• AOH 175th Anniversary Time Capsule (2018-2019) completed and located in Archives (open in 2093 or 2143 - by AOH 200th or 300 Anniversary, respectively)

March 01-31

- Archives closed for office and Reading Room repairs (internal and external services suspended)
- Second full-scale inventory audit of Archives general holdings conducted

April 01 – May 31

- Archives remains closed to accommodate nearby service elevator repairs (limited service provided to AOH Administration and Parish offices only – closed to external researchers)
- Restructuring of Archives space for improved storage, workspace, and workflow

Processing of accessions backlog and collection preservation assessment continues

May 01

- Archbishop Blair officially retired
- Coadjutor Archbishop Coyne officially instated as 6th Archbishop of Hartford (14th Bishop)

June 01

• AOH Archives re-opens and resumes essential internal services

 Office of Property & Assets transitions to new management role and relocates from Chancery (Hartford, CT) to Pastoral Center (Bloomfield, CT) – Archives remains at Chancery; new protocols enacted at Chancery
