†INDIVIDUAL RETIREMENT ACCOUNT (IRA) GIFTS

Beginning in 2023, the SECURE 2.0 Act raised the age that you must begin taking your first required minimum distribution (RMD) to age 73. If you reach age 72 in 2023, the required beginning date for your first RMD is April 1, 2025, for 2024, with subsequent RMDs on Dec 31 annually thereafter. You can give any amount up to \$100,000 per year from your IRA directly to a qualified charity without having to pay income tax on the money. This is known as an IRA charitable rollover.

Please consult your tax adviser and kindly instruct your retirement account broker to make the check payable to the **Archbishop's Annual Appeal, and mail it to 467 Bloomfield Avenue, Bloomfield, CT 06002.** Please call the Appeal office at (800) 781-2550 with any questions you may have regarding this gift.

†PLEDGED GIFTS

Appeal gifts may be paid over five months. Please consider including your first month's payment with your pledge card.
