Our parish is taking part in Newman Connection's Faith Forward movement, a national initiative designed to ensure that every high school senior is personally connected to a campus ministry, military chaplain, or young adult parish before they graduate.

Why is community important?

Starting a new chapter—whether at a new school, in a different state, joining the military, or entering a professional career—can make it challenging to find a community of like-minded friends. Finding community is vital for our students as they head off to college, join the military, or start their careers.

Fortunately, students can connect with a Catholic faith community wherever they are headed next with Faith Forward. **Faith Forward**, a national initiative. They offer much more than just worship opportunities like Mass and Adoration; they host fun activities, provide helpful resources, and create chances to build genuine friendships rooted in shared values.

But this effort isn't just for students in our schools — **if you know a high school senior, whether they're your child, grandchild, neighbor, or friend, now is the time to help them get connected.** Too many young Catholics feel lost and lose their faith simply because they never find a new spiritual home after high school.
